Dear Patient,

I am writing to inform you that I will be leaving Dermatology Consultants LLC effective October 29, 2026. After that date, I will no longer be able to provide you with medical care.

I will be available until October 29 to provide your dermatologic care. However, if you require continued care after that date, I suggest you make arrangements to establish yourself with another dermatologist. Unfortunately, Drs. Menon and Ahmadi have full practices and will not be able to accept my patients.

To assist you in continuing your dermatologic care, you may contact the American Academy of Dermatology by visiting <https://find-a-derm.aad.org> or call (888) 462-DERM (3376) to help identify a board-certified dermatologist who is accepting new patients. Please note that you are free to select any qualified healthcare provider of your choosing.

After October 29, you should not use my name as the ordering physician for laboratory studies or x-rays, as I will not be available to handle the results. You should also inform your current medical providers when you change dermatologists. Your reports should not be sent to our office, and neither I nor Drs. Menon nor Ahmadi will be able to write prescriptions for you. Prescriptions for medications which I prescribe will terminate no longer than 30 days after my departure so that you can obtain new prescriptions from your new physician.

Therefore, it is most important that you have an appointment in place with another dermatologist to continue your care after the above date.

Your medical records will remain with Dermatology Consultants LLC and will continue to be maintained in accordance with applicable laws and regulations. You may obtain a copy of your medical records or request that they be transferred to another healthcare provider upon our receipt of a written authorization form, which can be found on our website DermCNY.com. Please allow up to 2 weeks for the office to send your records.

It has been a privilege to participate in your dermatologic care, and I am grateful for the trust you have placed in me. Providing care for you has been both a professional honor and a personal pleasure.
